

Team Registration Notes (2020-21)

1 Registration Period

- 1.1 The team registration starts from 1st June 2020 to 31st May 2021.
- 1.2 The effective date of 2020-21 team registration is from 1st July 2020 to 30th June 2021.

2 Team Composition

- 2.1 At least two players for each team, up to three players.
- 2.2 The team needs to establish a team name. The name is strictly prohibited from using any indecent words, does not allow to use the word "Association", "Sports School" or other misleading titles is prohibited.
- 2.3 Players must be born on or before 31st December 2004.
- 2.4 Teams can make their own team logos and suits, but it is not necessary. The design of the logos or jerseys should not lead negative affect to the image of the Roundnet Sport, Hong Kong Roundnet Associations (HKRA) and Registered Clubs (RRC). HKRA has the right to prohibit the team from registration.

3 Categories of Registered Team

- 3.1 Registered teams can be classified into <u>Club affiliated Teams</u> or Normal Teams.
 - 3.1.1 Club affiliated Teams:
 - 3.1.1.1 The team registration should indicate the name of the club which it belongs. The application form requires the signature of the club's director.
 - 3.1.1.2 Only Club affiliated teams can join Inter-Club Tournament on behalf of the club.
 - 3.1.1.3 Each player can only represent one club.
 - 3.1.1.4 The registration fee for Club affiliated Teams is HK\$300 per year

3.1.2 Normal Teams

3.1.2.1 All the players that make up the team do not belong to any club,



3.1.2.2 Normal Teams registration fee is HK\$400 per year. •

4 Registration Guideline and amendment of team information

- 4.1 Each player can register up to two different teams, but the list of players of the any teams cannot be identical.
- 4.2 Teams need to fill out the application form, submit the form by mail or email to HKRA.
- 4.3 Each team is eligible to change the player list, up to twice per year.
- 4.4 Each team is eligible to change the club which belonged, up to twice per year.
- 4.5 The change of the player list and club transfer requires filling application form. The administrative procedure takes no less than 30 days. Before the completion of the procedure, team/players cannot represent new team or new club.
- 4.6 The administrative fee for each amendment application is HK\$50.
- 4.7 No limitation for changing other team information (such as changing jerseys, team logos, etc.), and the administrative fee is HK\$50 for each application.

5 Right of Registered Team

- 5.1 Tournament host by HKRA only allow for registered teams
- 5.2 The registered team's team logo, information and tournament results will be indicated on the HKRA website.
- 5.3 Registered teams automatically join <u>Team Ranking System</u>, and the team points earn from tournament will be recorded during the whole administrative year of HKRA (the current administrative year is 1st July 2020 to 30th June 2021.
- 5.4 Eligible for priority booking for HKRA's activities.

6 Responsibility of Registered Team

- 6.1 Registered teams must follow and obey the policies and tournament rules established by the HKRA
 - 6.1.1 Any information submitted by the registered team must be true and correct.
 - 6.1.2 Participating in any tournament, the players name must be constant to the player list registered. Tournament will not accept

any non-team players to play instead.

- 6.2 Registered teams must maintain a good and healthy image.
 - 6.2.1 Smoking is strictly prohibited during training and competition.
 - 6.2.2 Gambling, drug abuse, or other illegal activities in public places or tournament venues are strictly prohibited
 - 6.2.3 The registered team must follow the organizer's instruction and the tournament rules.
- 6.3 Registered teams must maintain good sportsmanship.
 - 6.3.1 Registered teams often respect each other, including coaches, teammates, opponents, referees and staffs in tournament.
 - 6.3.2 Club Affiliated Teams must follow the rules set by the club.
 - 6.3.3 The registered team shall not commit any violation, sabotage during the tournament.
 - 6.3.4 Registered teams or their players must not make malicious remarks about HKRA, RRC, teams or players through any kinds of media.

7 Disqualification of registered team

- 7.1 If any team violates the rules of this document, HKRA has the right to issue a warning to the team that violates the rules.
- 7.2 If any team receives any warning issued by HKRA and still commits any violation of this document, HKRA has the right to disqualify the team registration.
- 7.3 If the team's violations are very serious, HKRA has the right to disqualify the team registration without warning.
- 7.4 If the team is disqualified, the players listed are not able to participate in any kind of tournaments organized by the HKRA during the current administrative year.
- 7.5 The club is responsible for the management of all teams affiliated to the club. If any team affiliated to the club has serious violations of the rules, HKRA has the right to punish the club.
